### NEW DIRECT FLIGHTS: HO CHI MINH CITY → DIEN BIEN PHU

Vietnam Airlines launches direct flights from Ho Chi Minh City to Dien Bien Phu starting January 2025.

#### **HO CHI MINH CITY – Transfer of International Flights to new Long Thanh Airport – Programme Impact**

According to information communicated by Vietnam Airlines, **from mid-June 2026, all international flights TO / FROM Ho Chi Minh City will be transferred to the new Long Thanh International Airport**, located approximately 40 km from the city centre. The estimated transfer time is around **1 hour 30 minutes via expressway under normal traffic conditions**.

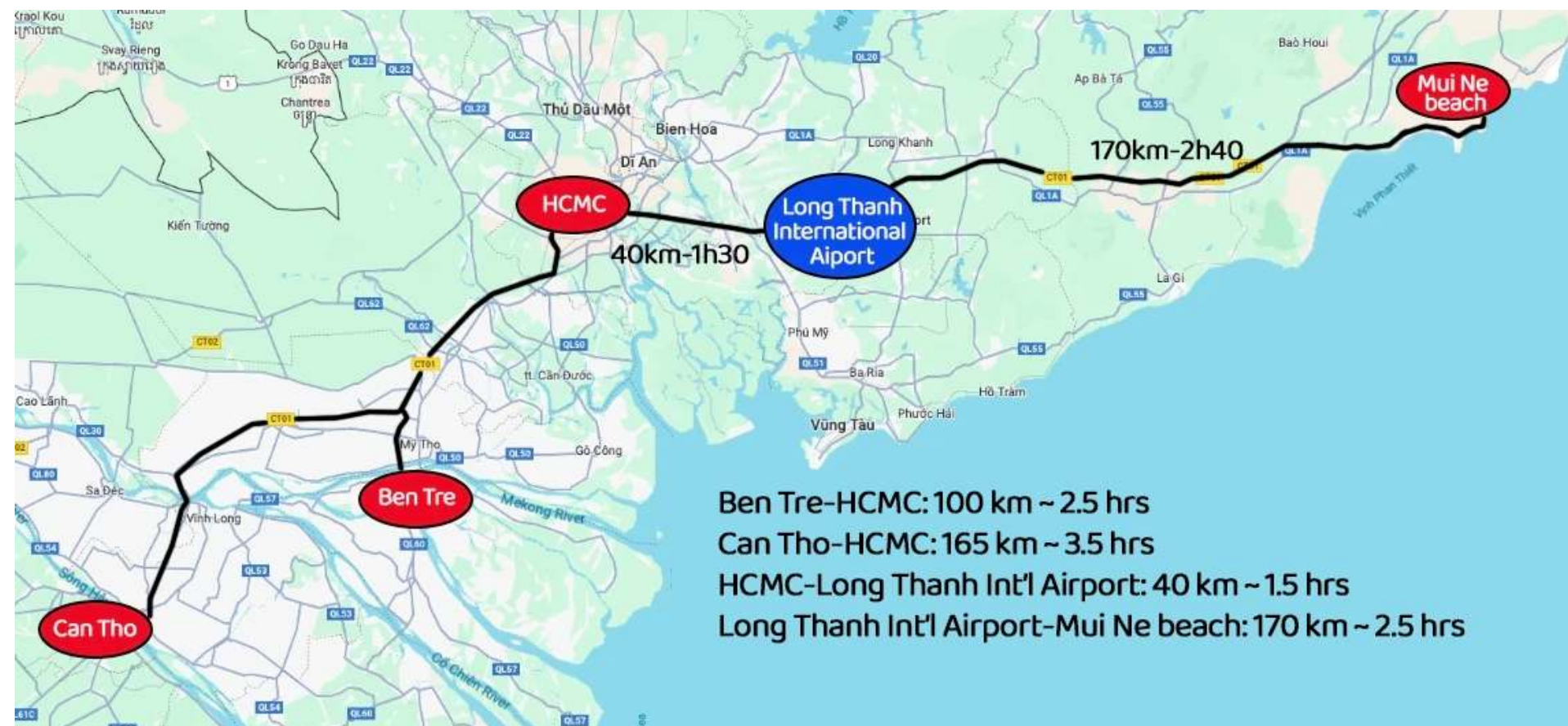
As a result, **please allow sufficient time for transfer and airport check-in (minimum 4 hours before departure)**.

- Artistic performance: *Sketching the Essence of Hanoi*, recreating defining moments such as the 1954 liberation of the capital.

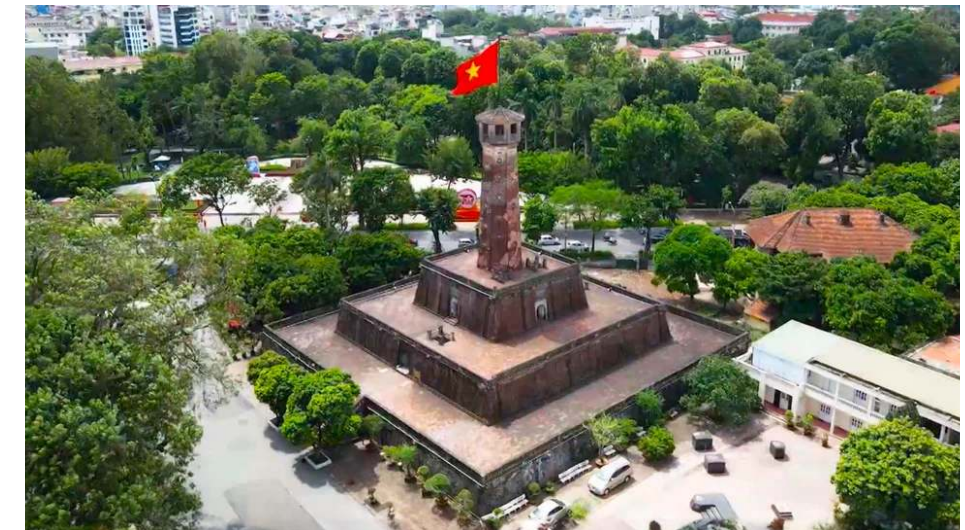
**Historical significance:**



- Built between 1805 and 1812 as part of the Hanoi Citadel.
- Survived French invasions and served as a strategic military post.
- National flag first raised after the August Revolution (1945).
- Raised again on 10 October 1954 to mark the liberation of Hanoi.
- Later used as an air-defence observatory during the American War.

**KHLAENG & SEREI TRADITIONAL KITE-FLYING FESTIVAL** – The second edition of this festival celebrates Khmer intangible cultural heritage through a vibrant programme of activities.

- **Organised by:** Siem Reap Province and the Department of Culture and Fine Arts
- **Period:** 6–8 February 2026
- **Venue:** Old Siem Reap International Airport
- Cultural performances and traditional music
- Artisan displays and local food stalls
- Demonstrations of traditional Khmer kite making

The event also aims to boost local tourism and engage younger generations with Cambodia’s cultural identity.



**HERITAGE, CULTURE & DINING - Siem Reap, Cambodia**

**Phum Boeung** - A living heritage village and cultural dining destination in Siem Reap, founded by Cambodian couple Vanna and Sorya, dedicated to preserving traditional Khmer architecture and rural ways of life.

**VIETNAM**

**TRÀ VINH - A HIDDEN GEM OF THE MEKONG DELTA - 3D/2N**



Discover Trà Vinh, a tranquil gem of the Mekong Delta, where Khmer-Vietnamese culture, lush farmland, local encounters and regional flavours come together in peaceful, unspoilt surroundings.

**Day 1: Ho Chi Minh City - Tra Vinh (D)**

Depart by car for Trà Vinh (150km-4 hours), a tranquil Mekong Delta province known for its Khmer heritage, elegant pagodas and fertile countryside. Check in to a comfortable lodge set among rice fields.

In the afternoon, join a Khmer mask-making workshop and prepare *cốm dẹp*, a local sticky rice and coconut delicacy, enjoyed sunset by the pool. Dinner is followed by an Apsara dance performance celebrating Khmer culture.

*Note: Activities are offered on a group basis.*

Overnight Thala Tra Vinh Lodge

**Day 2: Tra Vinh (BLD)**

After breakfast, set off on a 12km cycling ride through rice paddies, fruit gardens and traditional monkey bridges. Along the way, stop at a local home to learn about daily life, then visit a rice mill to see traditional processing methods.

Continue to an ancient Khmer pagoda, admired for its distinctive architecture, before meeting local farmers to discover Trà Vinh's prized *macapuno* coconut (locally known as *dừa sáp*), a rare variety unique to the region. Enjoy a refreshing drink made from this speciality, then cycle back to the lodge for lunch.

The afternoon is at leisure to unwind in the tranquil surroundings.

Later, savour a thoughtfully prepared five-course dinner made with homegrown produce. Before retiring for the night, unwind with a soothing herbal foot bath to end the day in complete relaxation.

After breakfast, check out and transfer to the next destination or return to Ho Chi Minh City.
